Group Assignment Briefing:

You are to work in the groups allocated by the facilitators into required no people/group please.

Tendering Submission Report by each group will be based around a project, that one or more of you in the group are currently working of familiar with.

We suggest that you do a quick once round the group and pre-select the project you all wish to do, based on current knowledge and known access to information.

The Group Tender Submission Reports will be in the form of Presentations, no longer than 10-15 minutes each viewed via shared screen online. A digital copy with Group Name and Members names to be supplied to Ronnie Matafeo via email rmatafeo@unitec.ac.nz.

Each Presentation requires a coordinated effort please, with each group member playing an equal part in the preparation and presentation(s). Each Group shall have a name..

For the purpose of this Group Assignment in relation to its Learning Outcomes, an Introduction Section is added as part of the Tender Submission Report. The Introduction Section information shall include, Project description, Main Reasons to Tender, Some of Risks incurred/identified and how you manage them, Any unique aspect in project, ie method of construction used, materials used, specialist equipment / subcontractor, design, etc, Reasons for "How much" P&G and Margins allowances have derived.

Unitec is assumed to be the Project Managers, so all Tender Letters should be addressed to Unitec School of Construction and Technology, 301 Carrington Road, Mt Albert, Attention: Ronnie Matafeo – Engineer to Contract)

There will be some baseline information during Day One worksheet sessions that will assist you in preparing for Group Assignment Day 2 presentations. Assumptions for Subcontractors Quotation amounts can be made on various Trades as required in the preparation of Trade Summary sheet.

- Proposed Construction Programme.
- Proposed Team Members for the project.
